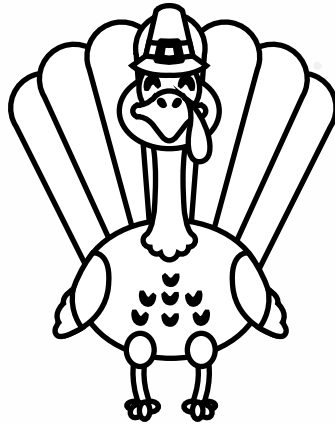
Hello Brookside Student!

### Rules

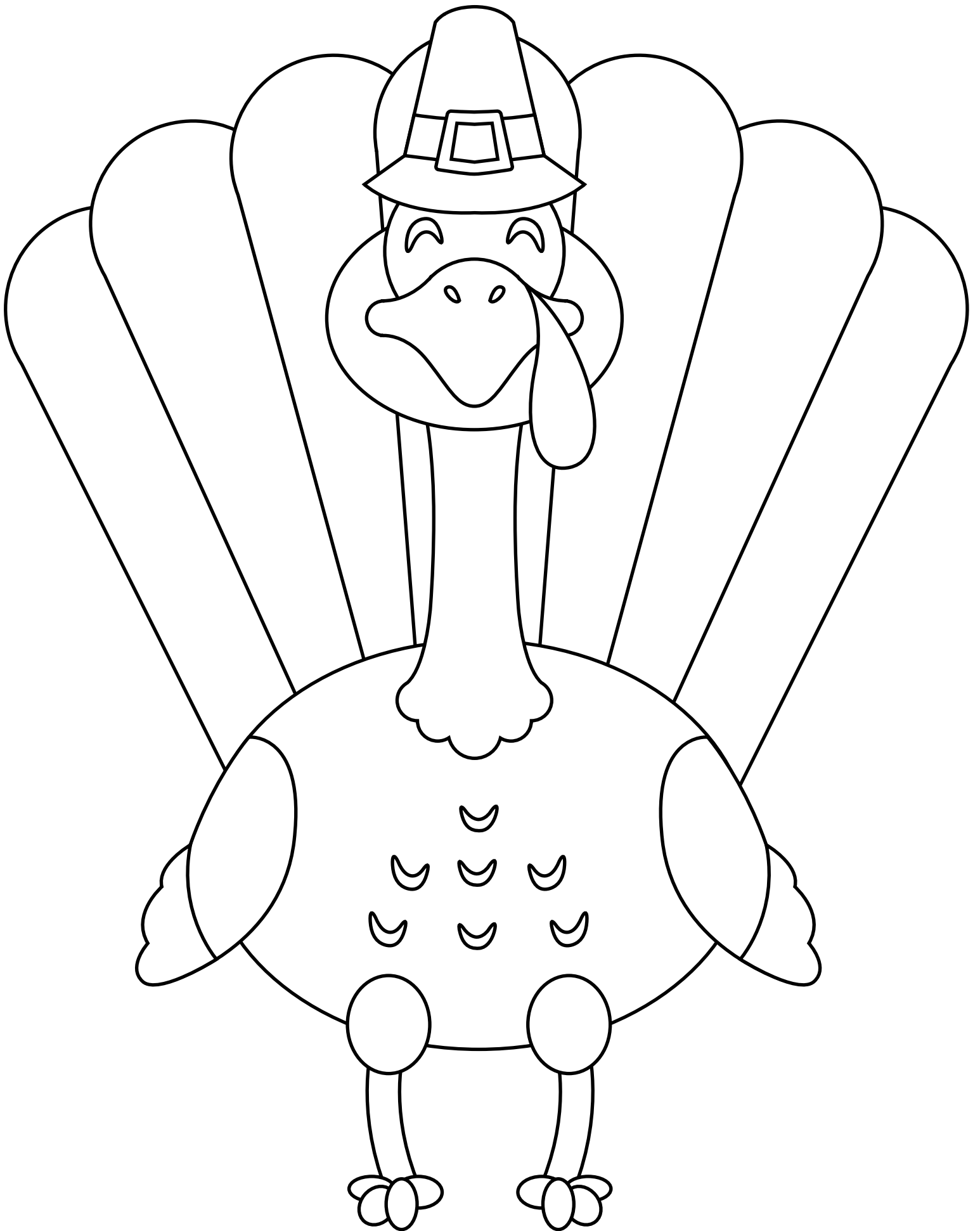

10. Winners will be announced on **Monday, November 30<sup>th</sup>.**

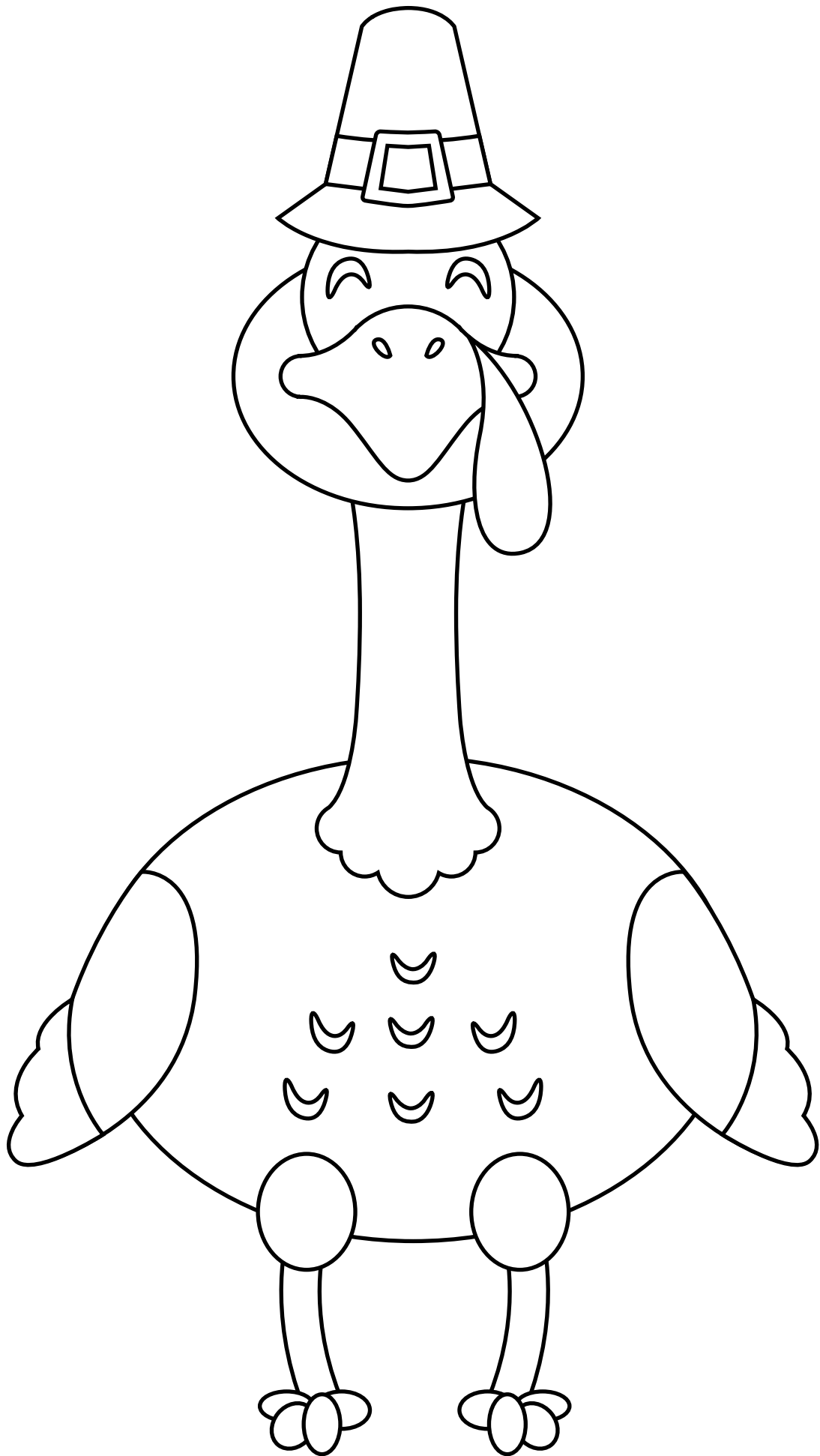




# Disguise the Turkey

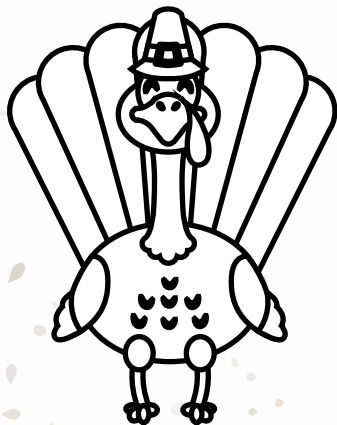
