

## Science educators attend meeting at Tewksbury HS

TEWKSBURY — Science educators from 23 Greater Boston communities attended the annual fall meeting of the Boston Area Physical Science Study Committee at the invitation of Lawrence McGowan, Principal, and Mrs. Elsie Pincantini, Head of the Science Department.

Improving physics teaching was the theme of the all-day meeting. The featured speaker was Olcut Gardner of Jamesville-DeWitte High School and Syracuse University. Mr. Gardner's subject was "Individually Prescribed Instruction in Secondary School Science," a challenging and provocative new approach to education.

OTHER features of the program include an exchange of science demonstrations by several physics instructors; a description of the MIT high school studies program by Steven Schwartz and Joan Friebele of MIT; a report on the use of individualized instruction in Harvard Project Physics by James Moore of Canton high school; a report on a multi-media multi-model program in physics by Sumner Richards of Lexington high school; and a description of programs for inservice education for high school physics teachers by Fred King and Fr. Louis St. Marie of Harvard Graduate School.

John Wynn, Superintendent of Schools in Tewksbury, expressed hope that exposure to these new methods of individualized instruction will be reflected in the schools of this community.

The program, sponsored by the Tewksbury Jaycees, was conducted by Atty. Stephen Hollman of Brookline, a deputy legal assistant in the Consumer Protection Division of the Attorney General's office.

Whether you were planning to buy a car for the family, a roast for Sunday's dinner, a magazine subscription or a major appliance as a Christmas

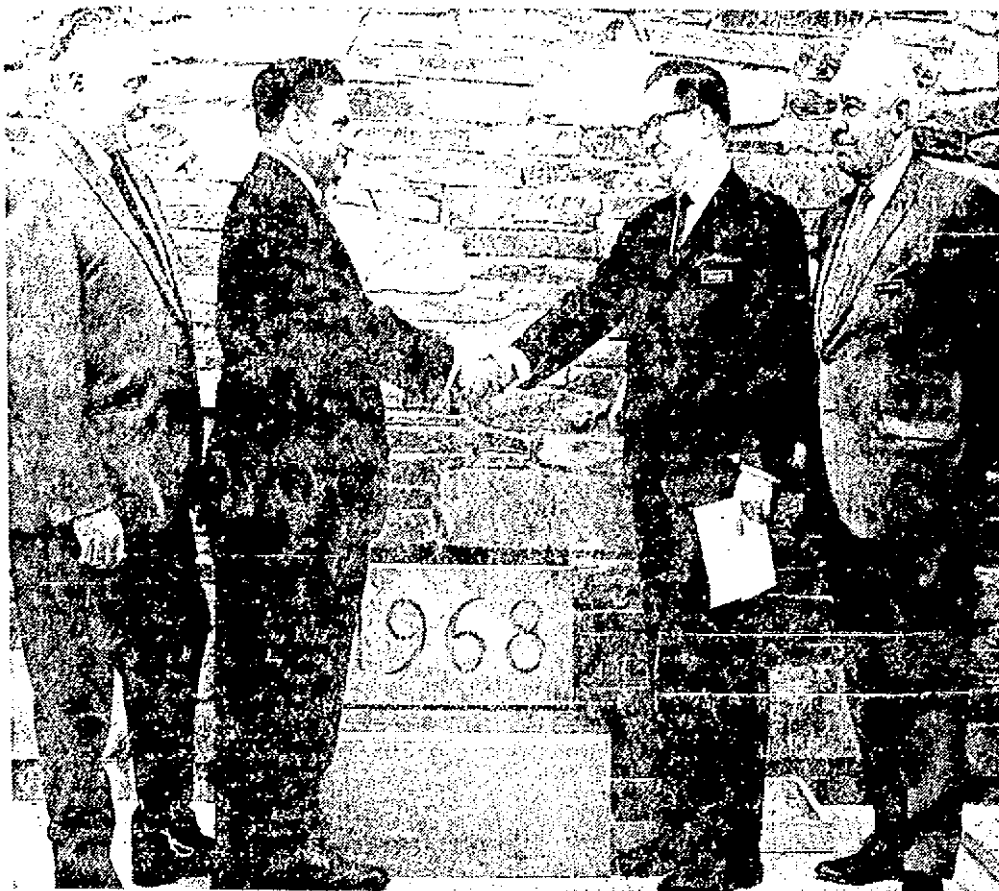

MR. HOLLMAN, describing Massachusetts' Consumer Protection Division as one of the most progressive in the nation, discussed the work of his agency in fighting consumer fraud and in enforcing the state's laws protecting the buyer.

He explained the various illegal gimmicks used by so-called "shady dealers," told how to avoid being caught by such unfair trade practices and consumers who had swallowed illegal bait.

In a day where such importance is placed on the dollar bill, the evening was outstanding in its explanation of how to protect and get the most for your money.

Nick Carbone, chairman of Consumer Protection, asked if he plans to repeat the event, said, "if the people of Tewksbury will request it. I am sure that the Jaycees would not let them down."

## Chelmsford Ministers to change pulpits

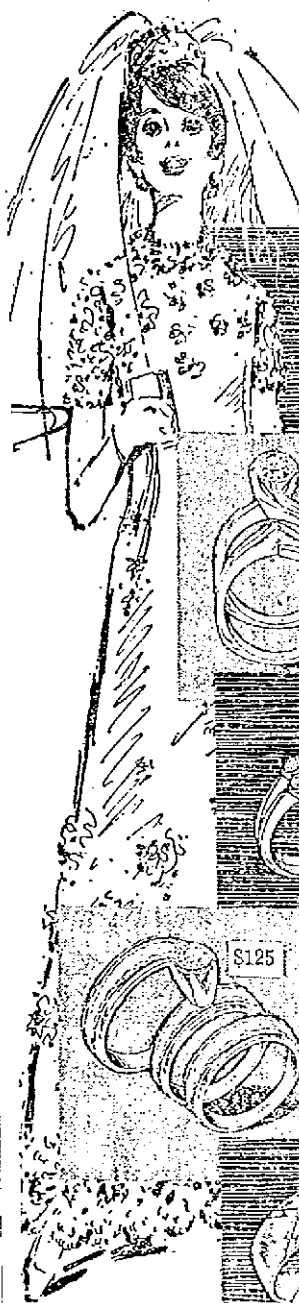

Meetings of the church school will be omitted Sunday.

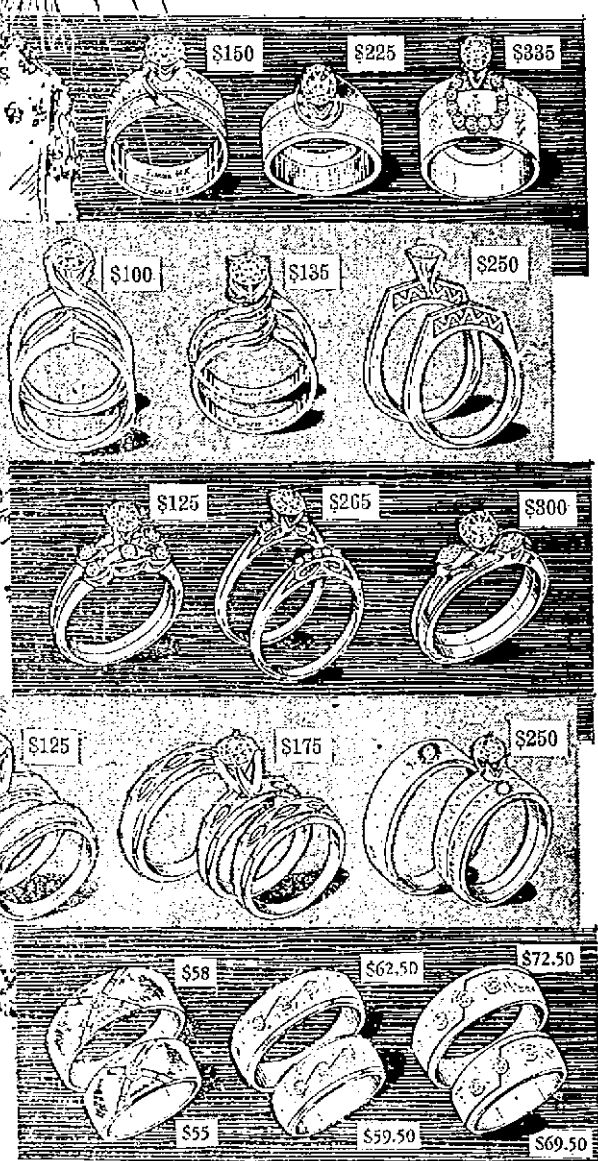
## Lone call

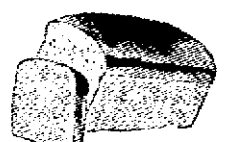

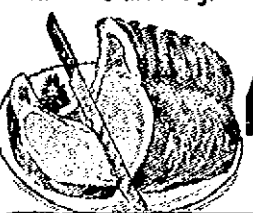
