### What is Title !?

Title I Part A of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act provides financial assistance to districts and schools with high numbers or high percentages of children from low-income families to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards.

- Strengthen the core program in schools and provide academic and/or support services to students at the elementary, and middle levels.
- Provide evidence-based programs that enable participating students to achieve the learning standards of the state curriculum frameworks; provide high quality instruction, and additional supports.
- Elevate the quality of instruction by providing staff with substantial opportunities for professional development.
- Involve parents/guardians as active partners in their children's education at school through open, meaningful communication through appropriate and inclusion needs in decision-making processes.
